Peripheral Artery Disease (PAD) - Peripheral artery disease is a narrowing of the arteries that carry blood flow to the legs. Left untreated, PAD can possibly result in gangrene or amputation.	Angioplasty Atherectomy

Varicose Veins/Chronic Venous Insufficiency (CVI)- Chronic venous insufficiency is a condition	Sclerotherapy
that occurs when the venous valves in the leg veins are not working effectively, making it difficult for	Endovenous Thermal Ablation
blood to return to the heart from the legs. CVI causes blood to "pool" or collect in these veins, this pooling is called stasis.	VenaSeal
May-Thurner Syndrome- A rare vascular disorder in which an artery compresses a vein in your	Venous Stenting
pelvis. This compression usually cause symptoms in the left leg and foot, rarely the right ,and may	
lead to blood clots.

Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia (BPH)- A condition in which the prostate is enlarged. With BPH, there	Prostate Artery Embolization

Varicocele- An enlargement of the veins within the scrotum, much like the varicose veins that appear	Varicocele Embolization
in the legs, that causes scrotal pain and infertility. It occurs in about one in six males.

Frozen Shoulder- Frozen shoulder, also called adhesive capsulitis, causes severe pain and stiffness in	Adhesive Capsulitis Embolization
the shoulder. Over time, the shoulder becomes very hard to move.	
Osteoarthritis of the Knee (OA)- Osteoarthritis is the most common form of arthritis. Some people	Genicular Artery Embolization
call it degenerative joint disease or "wear and tear" arthritis.	
Diabetic Neuropathy- Peripheral nerve damage caused by long-term high blood sugar levels	Spinal Cord Stimulation
Spinal Fractures- Compression fractures due to Osteoporosis that can occur from simple	Vertebroplasty
movements. Fractures are typically found in elderly patients.	Kyphoplasty
